SCHOLARSHIPS

In 2017, AMBC will be giving out three \$1,000 scholarships. Scholarships will be chosen from applications received and selected by the Charmaine Fennie Scholarship Fund Selection Committee. If for any reason a selected scholarship recipient becomes ineligible, an alternate recipient will be selected. Decisions of the Selection Committee are final.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship award program is open to any employee or family member of a mail and business center who has applied for or has been accepted at an institution of higher education (college, trade school, etc.), or is currently a registered student in good standing at an institution of higher education. Proof of acceptance by an institution of high education must be provided prior to delivery of any awards.
